ALTIDA



Ltd.), Mr. Alex Rajan (Director, HR, Pfizer), Mr. Sunil Chibber (Vice President, HR, Reliance Industries Limited), Mr. Alok Mehta(Director- HR, Metro Cash & Carry), Mr. Arun Kaimal (HR leader, GE Energy) were some of the distinguished people who spoke to the batch. The batch also had the honour of having Mr. Satish Pradhan (Executive Vice President, Group HR, Tata Sons) address them.

P. Sainath, Journalist

It was a privilege to have Mr. P. Sainath in our campus to address the students of TISS. P. Sainath is a well-known journalist (The Hindu Rural Affairs Editor). Stressing on the need for disruptive innovation, she opined how important it was to empathise with respect to a situation, business environment or even an individual case to get the start of the design thinking chain right.

Mathew Kuruvilla, VP, HR (Deutsche Bank)

On Saturday, the 4th of August the students of the 2011-13 batch of HRM and LR got the opportunity to interact with Mr. Mathew Kuruvilla, VP, HR for Global Technology, Finance and Risk in Deutsche Bank who came for a guest lecture on Organization Development. Mr. Mathew Kuruvilla emphasized on the need for HR professionals to move from mere metrics to more insight-based analysis. After providing us with great insights into the changing role of and demand from Human Resource professionals the class moved on to discuss organization life cycles. The third part of the lecture was based on a case study where students were divided into four groups and given a case study on Kingfisher Airlines. Not only was Mr. Kuruvilla able to explain to us certain difficult concepts with ease, he was also able to make it more interesting and concrete by introducing the element of the case.


