#### GUEST LECTURES - Prateek Kumar, Malvika Assija (2013-15 batch)

The HRM&LR batch of 2013-2015 had the wonderful opportunity to interact with several industry stalwarts as a part of the CHRO address series. Mr. Yogi Shriram (Senior VP, Corporate HR, Larsen and Toubro), Mr. Satish Pradhan (Advisor ,Tata Sons), Mr. Prabir Jha (CHRO,Tata Motors), Mr. Adil Malia (Group President HR at Essar Group), Mr. Rajeev Dubey (President of group HR, Mahindra & Mahindra), Ms. Aparna Sharma (Country Head, HR, Lafarge India), Dr. Santrupt Misra (Director, Global HR & CEO, Carbon Black Business at Aditya Birla Group) were amongst a few names who honoured the batch with their inspiring and enterprising success stories.



The batch had a lot to take away from these guest lectures that opened the horizons of students to the gradual evolution and challenges that are shaping the HR profession today. Straight from the industry and real life experiences from the guest speakers gave way to very enthusiastic and inquisitive interactions between the students and the speakers.

The anecdotes shared by the speakers highlighted the significance of networking and engagements, the importance of emotional connect with employees and the hallmarks of a good leader. The series of guest lectures indeed laid a strong foundation to the formative thought processes of the future HR professionals of the batch.

#### FIELDWORK ROUND TABLE - Saniya Malim (2013-15 Batch)

A field work round table was organized for students of HRM&LR batch 2013-15 on 18th June 2013 with a purpose to familiarize them and answer all their queries related to field work. The round table was graced by prominent TISS Alumni: Prof Vijayan, Dean-HR, Welingkar School of Management; Mr. Arun Kaimal, HR Manager, GE Aviation; Ms. Kanchana Manyam, Additional General Manager - Group HR, Shapoorji Pallonji & Co.Ltd; Ms. Riddhi Parikh, Human Resources Manager at Johnson & Johnson; Ms. Nitya Pant, Learning & Development Manager at Marico, Prof Vijay Kumar, TISS.

All of them re-lived their field work experiences sharing valuable insights on how to maximize one's learning and get the best out of this opportunity so unique to TISSians, and also on the do's and don'ts of field work. The speakers emphasized on understanding the rationale behind each task and focusing on 'Why' rather than 'What'. The session concluded with Prof Vijayan's enriching advice of using field work as a golden opportunity for understanding the practice and translating it into useful knowledge.

#### INDUSTRIAL VISIT - Devika Shanbhag & Srinidhi Ramesh (2013-15 Batch)

Crompton Greaves - On the 24th June, 2013, students of HRM&LR batch 2013-15 visited Crompton Greaves(CG) at Kanjurmarg, Mumbai. Mr. Sanjay Jorapur, global HR Head, apprised the students of how CG has evolved as one of the forerunners in the field of design, manufacturing, and marketing of products related to power generation, transmission, and distribution. He also took the students through the history and milestones of the company, followed by an introduction to the HR Operating Model in place. The students were then taken through the organization chart of the company followed by a shop floor visit.

Asian Paints - Students of HRM&LR batch 2013-15 visited Asian Paints plant at Bhandup on 25th June, 2013. They were given a presentation by Mr.Agashe, HRD covering the locations, strengths, businesses and human resources of Asian Paints followed by a highly interactive session, with queries related to Trade Unions, Industrial Relations, and Employee Engagement. This was followed by a session on employee welfare and the steps taken by the company towards the welfare of the workers. The visit concluded with a tour of the plant.

#### SESSION ON SEXUAL HARASSMENT - Sailakshmi Arunachalam (2013-15 Batch)

The batch of 2013-15 of HRM & LR attended a workshop on curtailing sexual assault at public places on July 13, 2013 organized by the Committee Against Sexual Harassment, TISS. Manwinder Singh and Pradeep Singh, alumni of TISS, enlightened the students on their new initiative 'IndiaOYE' (India Open your Eyes) that under the aegis of Mumbai Police strives to reduce incidents of sexual harassment. The main objective of the session was to brainstorm for innovative ideas to spread the word to the common man.

#### RCF SAP WORKSHOP FOR 2012-14 BATCH

The HRM & LR batch of 2012-14 underwent a two day training program on Human Resource Information Systems on an ERP platform. The training program was conducted by RCF Ltd, Mumbai from 24th to 27th of July in two batches. This is the 4th year for this successful program which has given the student community an exposure to IT platforms in use at corporates.

#### DNA OF NEGOTIATONS - Dr. Gaurav Mehta (2012-14 Batch)

We had the privilege to listen to Dr. Avinash Deolekar, Sr. VP – People Strategy at Indofil Chemicals, on the various real-life intricacies associated with negotiations, particularly those between management and the union/s. The session was very interactive in nature and was complimented by discussions and debate on a live case study as well as a role-play.

Dr. Deolekar has extensive experience in the area, including the famous closure of the Naroda plant of PepsiCo, and this was evident from the various examples that he cited. It came as a pleasant surprise to see someone from the industry underscore his experiences with the relevant theories of negotiations. Overall, the session was a significant value addition to the existing theoretical framework in the minds of the students, building upon the previous session on the same subject.

#### WORKSHOP ON BUSINESS COMMUNICATION - Jaya Jyoti (2013 - 15)

On June 25, 2013 students of HRM & LR batch 2013-15 attended a workshop on Business Communication conducted by Ms. Sangeeta Rajan. The session highlighted the various nuances of effective communication through group exercises and demonstrations. It was followed by an elucidation of the concept of 'Active Listening' that essentially leads to intelligent questioning skills. The session concluded with reemphasizing the difference effective communication skills could make in the business world.

#### 2013-15 BATCH - Prof. Abhishek Kumar

The MA in Human Resource Management and Labor Relations program, which has traditionally boasted of such differences among individual students upon which their collective learning thrives, decreasing batch diversity over the last few years was a cause of concern. TISS, in a way then, was becoming like 'any other B-School', which afterall, we are proudly not.

This year's batch was a pleasant outcome of sustained efforts directed towards the achievement of the proud legacy of diversity. While the rest of the A-League Schools have majority of their 'intellectual' diversity coming from engineering background and related work experience, TISS has more than one-third of its batch coming from the arts, commerce and pure sciences, the average work-experience being upto 8 years in similarly diverse fields. While the rest of the institutes struggle to keep the gender ratio to a minimum acceptable level, the HR Batch at TISS has more than 40% females. And of course there is a diverse cultural mix with students coming from all over the country, a good number from rural backgrounds. With such rich diversity, we collectively aspire to build a tradition of people-centric education that has no match in the world of Business Schools. We are not one afterall; Our goals being as diverse – among them, the creation of a better world.

#### UTTARAKHAND RELIEF ACTIVITIES - Rahul S K N (2012-14 Batch)

In June 2013, a multi-day cloudburst centred on the state of Uttarakhand caused devastating floods and landslides in what was one of the country's worst natural disasters. As of 16 July 2013, according to figures provided by the Uttarakhand government, more than 5,700 people were "presumed dead". With this backdrop TISS community stood up as it always has and is executing relief activities at the site of impact. HRM & LR batches of 2014 & 2015 made a monetary contribution of Rs.25,000/- to the directors fund on this cause. A gesture which was intended on enabling help and relief than quantifying namesake remittance, it was appreciated favourably by the Director S Parasuraman himself and supported by Dean D K Srivasthava as well.

Pankaj Raut, from the HRM & LR batch of 2012 -14, was a part of the TISS team which visited the disaster hit areas of Uttarkhand for an extensive field survey of the damage to the people and property.

#### PLACEMENT REPORT - Placement Committee



Manufacturing: 15%, FMCG: 13%, BFSI: 9%, Consulting: 11%, Pharma: 5%, Conglomerate: 20%, Others: 7%, IT/ITES: 20%

The final placements for the 2011-13 batch were held in January 2013 and lasted for three days. A total of 34 companies from various sectors participated in the process. Students of 2011-13 batch received offers from companies belonging to sectors such as FMCG, Conglomerate, IT/ITES, Pharmaceuticals etc.

The average offer accepted for the batch of 56 was ₹ 14.17 lakhs per annum. The highest offer made was ₹ 21.7 lakhs per annum and the lowest was ₹ 8 lakhs per annum. The international offer made was ₹60 lakhs per annum.
